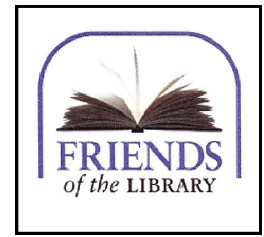

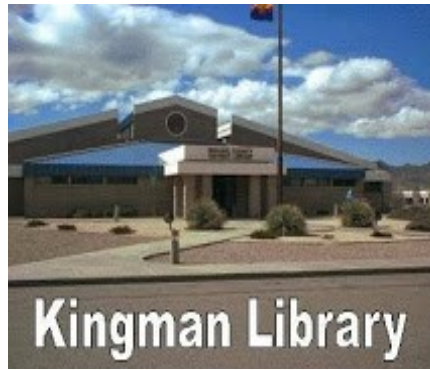

The Mystery of the ISBN Code

The Book Coordinators have been busy this summer sorting books again. We have found an outside vendor for some of the books that languish at our sales way too long. In order to know which books to send, we have been inputting the ISBN numbers to the webpage to find out if the company wants the book. As I was working away I began to wonder just what do those numbers mean.

This is what I found. **The International Standard Book Number** is a unique numeric book identifier. It started out in 1965 as a 9 digit commercial book identifier for book sellers. The 10 digit format was developed by the International Organization for Standardization in 1970. In 2007 the ISBN added three more digits to make it 13 digits long.

There are 5 parts to a 13 digit ISBN and each element is separated by a hyphen:

978-0-425-21746-1

1. A prefix element usually 978 or 979
2. The registration group element (the language – sharing country group or the individual country group) for example books published in English are 0 or 1
3. The registrant group – This identifies a particular country , geographical area and it ranges from 1 to 5 digits in length
4. The publisher group – this identifies particular publishers and can be up to 7 digits in length
5. Check sum digit – used for error detection in the formation of the bar code.

Every bar code is different and even if the title is in several formats each will have its own unique bar code. So now you know what I know. Still can't decipher each bar code but can tell a little bit more about the book. Now, if I could figure out what the book seller wants, I wouldn't have to scan so many titles.
